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STATISTICS REPORT

Over the course of 20 months, we monitored our staff population on various strands of diversity.

A link to a carefully curated survey was sent out to the whole business. This survey included questions relating to protected groups within ED&I and the results were then collated and compared, year on year across three periods – July 21, Dec 2, July 22, and Feb 23.
